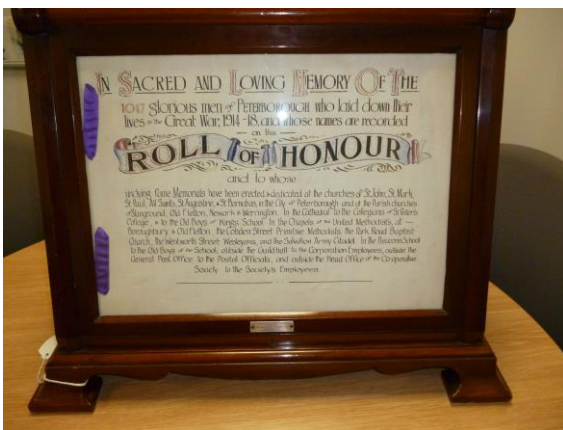

“CRAFTSMEN at a city firm have restored a unique wooden case which was made 65 years ago.

The box at the Memorial wing at Peterborough District Hospital contains what is believed to be the only complete list of Peterborough's 1,047 men who died in the First World War.

The mahogany box had remained unopened at the hospital for many years until the Family History Society decided it wanted to look at the roll of honour inside.”



The Roll of Honour is now in the custody of the Company Secretary at Peterborough City Hospital and is displayed in the Faith Centre in the days before and after Remembrance Sunday.
